The Exploration Series is a developmentally-appropriate after school program built on high-engagement discovery learning activities, games, and self-reflection designed to grow competencies in the following areas:

Each lesson is a 20-minute discovery learning experience that engages students cognitively, physically, and emotionally. This helps students internalize the competencies they are practicing while also appealing to the many different ways a student may learn best.

The Exploration Series Student Guide is designed for students to engage with them in unique ways and make them their own. This includes completing activities such as adding color, folding, cutting, or doodling.

There are 130 lessons in each level.
