DEFINITION

Values clarification refers to the reflective process of identifying one's personal beliefs and priorities. This essential skill not only enables students to set meaningful goals but also guides them in making decisions about how best to achieve them. By engaging in values clarification, students are empowered with a strong sense of purpose, which directly impacts their drive and motivation to succeed in reaching their aspirations.

Peter, Park, & Seligman's *Meaning of Life Theory* (2005) asserts that coherence, purpose, and significance contribute to a person's sense of meaning. Here are some ways these research-backed dimensions can be applied in your school:

- 1. Coherence: Making sense of experience, self, and the world

 Create activities and lessons that help students connect the strengths or skills they are developing to
 envision a thriving future life, emphasizing how different elements of what they are learning align with
 these strengths and skills.
- 2. Purpose: The act of pursuing or achieving goals

 Teach students how to match their goals with their values, fostering long-term motivation to drive short-term actions.
- 3. Significance: A sense of importance; feeling as though one's existence matters to others Integrate lessons about important interpersonal concepts like bullying, kindness, compassion, and belongingness, showing students how they can make a difference in the larger world by contributing to a more inclusive and appreciative school environment.
