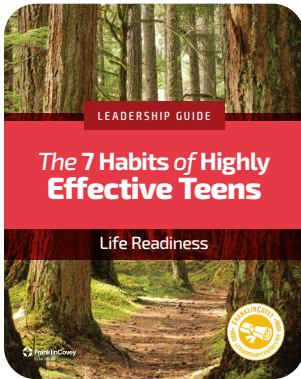

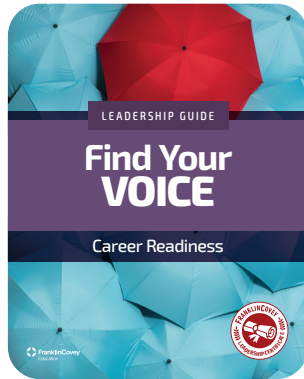

Leader in Me Secondary Schools encourage every student in the school to be involved in leadership development, including a student action team connected to an area of interest for them.



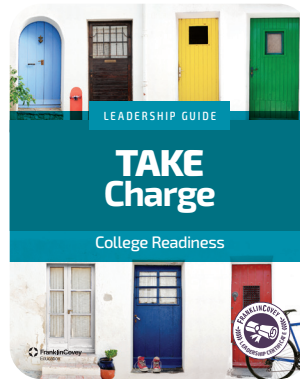

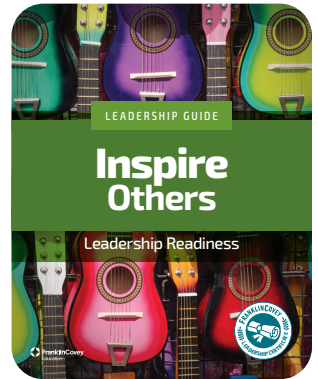

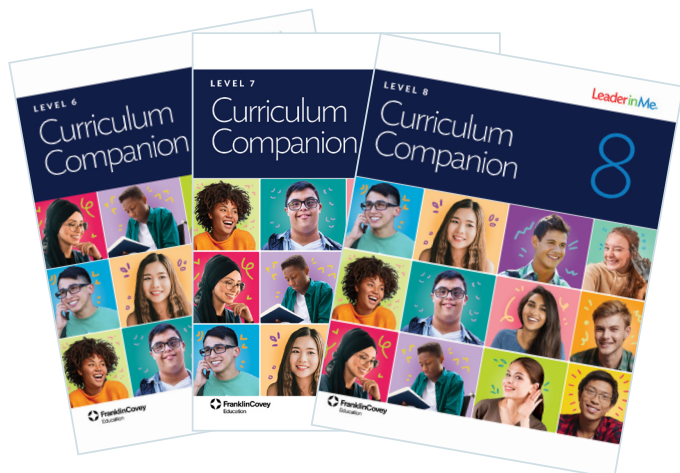
